How can schools create a learning environment which values compassion and mutual respect equally with academic performance? One where students are engaged, learning is joyful and staff and students thrive?

The principles of Dr Marshall Rosenberg's Nonviolent Communication and Positive Education show how strong relationships are key to creating a positive culture. Topics covered include how to:

- Create a shared language based on feelings and needs
- Teach empathy skills to everyone
- Develop a shared understanding about 'how we do it here'
- Develop non-punitive responses to manage mistakes humanely
- Model trust, forgiveness and mutual responsibility.

This one-day workshop will be interactive and activity-based with participants invited to use their own examples for practice. The workshop is for principals, teachers and support and administration staff.
